



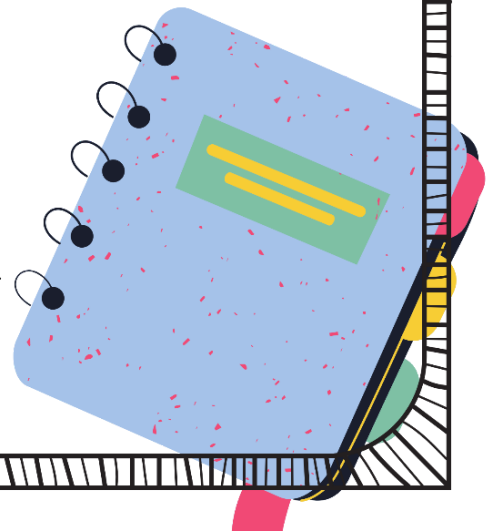

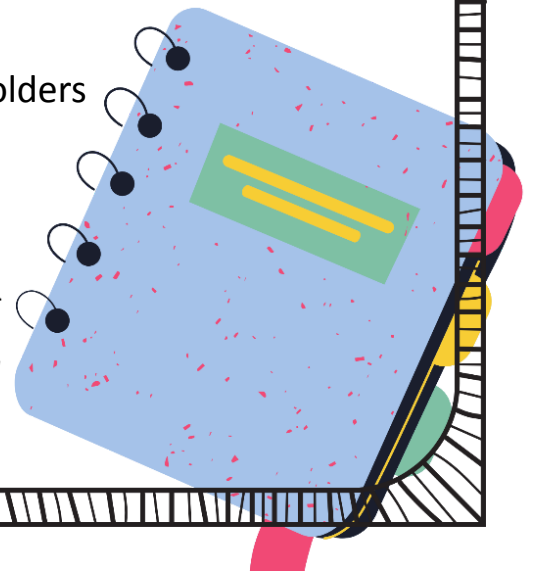

- Earbuds or headphones to use with chromebooks

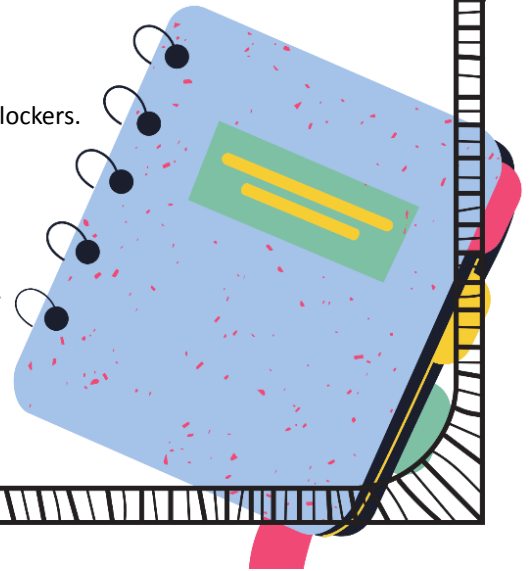

Here is a list of items we will need for our classroom. While these supplies are not required for 4th grade, they are greatly appreciated!

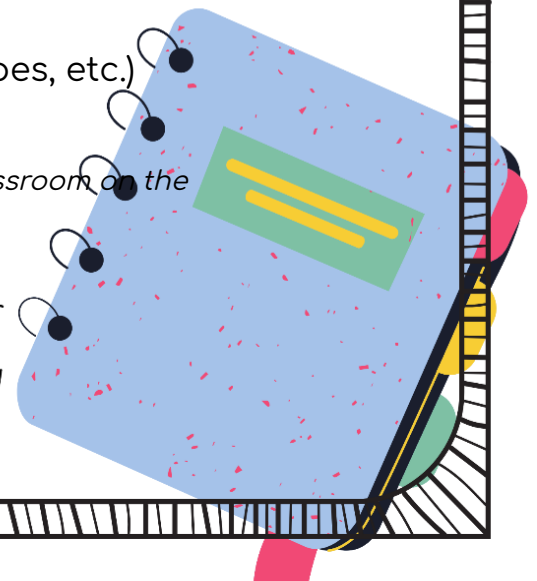
- Headphones/earbuds (for personal use with Chromebooks)
