

Community Council Meeting Minutes for 03/09/2019

Agenda Items were passed out for review.

First Item was discussion and approval of the 2020-2021 staffing plan. The school lost approximately \$50,000 in Title One funding so the amount for the upcoming year is about \$200,000. Also due to reduced enrollment, the number of FTE's has been reduced to 18.5,

The Trust Lands budget is \$67,000, which allows \$53,000 for an FTE, and the remaining \$14,000 will be used toward paraprofessionals.

This gives the school 19.5 FTE.

Class sizes for next year will be very similar to this year, with the exception of 6th grade, which is estimated at 33 students per class.

The proposal for staffing was approved unanimously.

Next, we discussed the reconfiguration meeting from last week which provided information about moving 6th grade. Pros and cons were expressed. At this point, the idea is up in the air, and no further information is yet available.

Finally, Mr. Johnson expressed his desire to have more diversity at our meetings, and ask the members to encourage people to attend.

The meeting then adjourned.
