

Meeting Notes
Pioneer Elementary Community Council
February 11th, 2019

First order of Business was to review and approve the SSAP for 2019-2020. Our school grade improved to a C, which is a noteworthy achievement. A review of our interventions and programs for general and special education students remained unchanged. Our goals for ELA and for Mathematics are to increase class averages by 20% on the final post test, and increase our total of students in the proficiency range by 3%. Our goals were reviewed including Professional Development, small groups and data usage to inform instruction. Parent and Community Engagement includes activities, (Math Night, KUED nights, Movie nights, Santa visit, etc), our Community Center, and the monthly newsletter. Our school needs 100% of our teachers to have a web site, and our SEP attendance to increase from 88% to 92%. Another factor is our School-Wide Behavior Plan.

Ms. Olsen proposed we accept the plan, Ms. Bishop seconded, and plan was approved unanimously.

The next item was the Trustlands Budget from the current year, and for 2019-2020. We reviewed the proposed budget, and it remains the same from last year as far as usage of funds, however the budget is larger and the expenditures are proportionally larger also.

Ms. Bishop proposed we accept the budget, Ms. Olsen seconded, and the budget passed unanimously.

Next, we discussed the Family and Community Center. Ms. Keyonnie provided information on families using the benefit, and what the center offers, including classes and food assistance. She feels it is going well and wants to keep it going for next year also.

Finally, Ms. Olsen proposed we adjourn, it was seconded by all, and the meeting was over.
