

Meeting Notes  
Pioneer Elementary Community Council  
October 8th, 2018

Meeting began with intros and welcome to Mr. Bawden.  
Ms. Olsen proposed opening meeting, Ms. Thomas seconded.

First order of business was Mr. Bawden, who came to thank the members and observe for a few minutes. He expressed gratitude for the involvement of the council members.

Secondly, we reviewed the current FTE status. We were appointed .5 increase, and fortunately were able to split our half day class and give Ms. Hamula full FTE status.

Third, we were informed our budget for 2019-2020 is going up 15%. This is a sizable increase that we welcome.

Next followed a discussion that is in the beginning stages concerning moving 6th grade to middle school or junior high. This decision will be community driven, and not district mandated. When implemented, the process takes about a year to occur. CC and parent input are the decision makers. The 6th grade teachers usually migrate with the students. This is a discussion we need to think about for the future. The decision is presented to the Board of Education, who make the final decision.

Next item we discussed was trying to get more parental and community support. KUED night and similar events can help. Discussion about updating math night events, as they have been the same for the last few events.
