## Pioneer Community Council Meeting

In Attendance: Grant Bushman, Corine Keyonnie, Maria Slo, Lindsey Weaver, Doug Johnson, John Cederlund

First Item of Business: Introductions were made. Grant Bushman and Lindsey Weaver are new to the Council.

Next, FTE Update. Attendance was projected at 451, which is an average of 27.25 per classroom. We are at that projection. The final student count is Friday, September 24th. Depending on our numbers then we will find out whether staffing will stay the same or if we will lose 0.5 FTE.

Budget Update: Our budget was \$66467, which we used to fund our 6 paraeducators. There is a surplus of \$2723.74 after an expenditure of \$940.94 to fund computer hardware. The amount was insufficient to fund an FTE position.

Teacher/Student/Parent Compact. This document will be distributed to parents at SEPs. It was unanimously approved. Copies will be printed 2-sided in English and Spanish.

The final agenda item was concerning increasing support for our PTA and our Community Council. It was proposed that the school send a note home on SEP nights. During these 2 evenings, both the PTA and the Family Center will have tables for sign up and information. PTA wanted to stress that joining the PTA is not a time consuming thing, and paying dues was really the most important. Parents can be as engaged as they wish.

Flu shots will be available during the first night of SEPs, September 29th.

Grant asked some demographic questions so he could try to get some idea of the school community.
