

Community Council Minutes 11/8/2021

Meeting started at 4:03, Grant made a motion to begin, and Maria seconded. Loura was introduced as PTA president. Corine informed the Council that the Community Center was serving other schools-Granger, Rolling Meadows and Frost.

The FTE change from 1st grade to Kindergarten was discussed. There are now 3 full day kindergarten classes of approximately 18 students, and 2 1st grade classes of approximately 24 students.
