

Pioneer Community Council Minutes
Sep 12, 2022

Meeting commenced at 4:00 p.m. In Attendance: Doug Johnson, Corine Keyonne, Loura Texeira, John Cederlund. On the phone: Maria Sio. Arrived during meeting: Rachel Lowry. Absent: Grant Bushman

Corine moved to open the meeting, Loura seconded.

First item was FTE update and Kinder Status.

OEK provides for 2 ½ FTE. This is thru the district. This leaves ½ FTE to provide for the 3 kinder teachers. FTE adjustment will be made on 9-26-2022, at the moment we are down 1 FTE due to our enrollment. It was projected at 441, and is currently 414. We have the ESSER grant, provided for Covid relief, that can cover this so we do not have to surplus a teacher. However, the ESSER grant is only good for this year.

Next is the Land Trust Update.

This is the money we use to fund the paraeducators. It is unchanged from the previous year.

The council will watch the training videos that are required each year at the next meeting.

Finally, we discussed gathering support for our school, our council and the PTA. Loura said the chocolate fund raiser will be coming up next week. This is a good chance to drive membership and raise money for the PTA. There will be a sign up desk during the parent teacher conferences. Also, there is a membership drive with a pie in the face of the administrators as a reward. This will be a class competition. Doug discussed the idea of rewarding the teachers if they all join PTA. This could be a lunch or something similar. There will be a book fair from October 17th to October 21st, in Relo 3. It will be open before school, during lunch and after school.

There will also be a Secret Santa store in December.

John moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Corine. Meeting adjourned.
