We discussed the Cyprus High School 9-12 reconfiguration meeting.

Push for attendance as it has been placed as a graduation expectation in the high schools. We feel it is very important for the children to understand the importance of attending class, and being on time. The School will continue to run class rewards for the best attendance. The children are enjoying the prizes and competition.

The CC discussed lunch room order. Dr Prescott proposes to give points and have competition on good lunchroom behavior. They will reward class prizes and Teacher prizes. Suggestions were made to require the kids to stay in the lunchroom 10 minutes to encourage them to eat. A lot of children will be in and out of the lunch room within 5 minutes. They are not eating the food and just wanting to play. It was also mentioned that other children feel rushed out of the lunchroom. Dr Prescott let us know that the children that have not finished eating are encouraged to move to another table to accommodate the other children coming into the lunch room to eat. Dr Prescott also informed us that starting next year students can no longer help with lunch duty. They will be hiring new lunch server.

As a follow up to our last meeting we reviewed the parking enforcement. This is not new but we have started to make sure that parents are informed of the correct parking/drop off requirements. Larene made barricades and the PTA has been monitoring this. The safety patrol will take over barricade. Parking has improved. Thank you Mr Woodhead for suggestion to have teachers park in the rear. This small change has made it beneficial to the Kindergarten and Preschool parents that need to park and walk their children to class. Safety of children letter will go home in the first day packet to be sent home in the front of the packet.
