## Drop-Off/ Pick-up

### Procedure

#### Safety of Children

The safety of children is of great importance in our community. We appreciate Salt Lake County for providing crosswalks, school zone signs, flashing lights, and crossing guards to help our students get to school safely. We teach the students good practices while being pedestrians and riding their bikes, scooters and skateboards; once on school grounds, students need to dismount and walk. Students should lock their bikes in the racks provided on the south side of the school. Scooters and skateboards may be stored in the classroom if space allows. **The school does not assume responsibility for lost, stolen or vandalized bikes, scooters or skateboards brought to school.** 

#### Bus Zone

The Bus Zone in front of the school is indicated by BUSES ONLY signs. **Only school buses are allowed in that area during school hours (8:30am-4:00pm).** Day care vehicles are to use the Student Loading/Unloading areas only. Students must use designated crosswalk area to cross the Bus Zone; parents should not encourage their children to cross the Bus Zone outside the crosswalk to get to their cars parked on 2700 South. The Bus Zone should not be used as a loading/unloading area for students **or as a parking area at any time.** 

#### Student Unloading Area

The curb on the West side of the school in the parking area is designated as the Student Loading/Unloading area. This is NOT a parking area; drivers must remain in their vehicles while waiting in this area. All parking must be done in the designated parking stalls in the parking lot. Vehicles parked in the handicapped stalls MUST have the appropriate handicapped license plate or window tag. Waiting is permitted at the curb; the two lanes indicated by the white lines are for moving vehicles only and not for student loading/unloading.

Students and patrons must use the crosswalk to access parked cars in the parking lot; for safety reasons, parents should not encourage their children to cross the parking lot outside of the crosswalk. A duty supervises the crosswalk after school. Access to the crosswalk from the sidewalk is indicated by the red curb which means no parking or waiting. We encourage parents using the Student Loading/Unloading area to teach their children safety practices about exiting/entering the vehicles during these busy before/after school times.

Please review the provided map to help you understand the flow of traffic for drop-off and pick-up of students.

Please obey traffic laws and the directions of faculty and staff directing traffic. Safety is the top concern.
