The staff at Pleasant Green have worked and will continue to work tirelessly to ensure that the environment we provide to our students is the safest we can possibly obtain in these circumstances. It is encouraged that parents review our school plan, located on our website so you are all familiar with what implementations will be made to accommodate all CDC, Local Health Department, and District guidelines.

As many already know, MASKS ARE REQUIRED to be worn while on school grounds. This is a state mandate that is non-negotiable. Each face-to-face learning student will be provided with one reusable cloth mask that can be taken home each day for cleaning and returned with the student the next day. You are welcome to have your students wear masks of their choosing so long as they fall within dress code (No bandanas or vulgar words/images will be tolerated). Face shields of any type are not an acceptable replacement to a mask. Disposable masks will be available to those who forget to bring one.

Our current schedule is regular school hours (9:05am-3:45pm) Monday-Thursday and distance learning for ALL on Friday. Planning (Early) days will only apply to those Thursdays already scheduled on the district calendar. Work for Distant Learning Friday's will be sent home on Thursdays and expected to be returned on Monday. We will not be sending a Chromebook home for Friday distant learning; all work will be in paper form. In the event that we are asked to adapt to a different learning modality, such as Hybrid or Distant Learning for all, we will adjust accordingly with the help and effort of everyone.

We understand the ever-changing information can be overwhelming and unsettling at times, but we are dedicated to providing the most up-to-date information as it comes. To help us help you, we ask that parents utilize our social media and websites on a regular basis as we continue to update and provide information as it becomes available to us.
