2. LAND trust

LANDtrust platform is finally working. Allison will get it updated as soon as possible. SCC members should receive an email later today once it is completed.

- -Next year's goals- Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP)
 - 1. Increase POP (Pathways of Progress) by 5% from beginning of year to end.
 - 2. Math goal- increase RISE proficiency by 5%

Action Steps for reading and math:

- 1. Differentiation- small & flex grouping
- 2. Social-emotional learning
- 3. Family engagement
- -Spending will be similar to money spent in previous years, including money for paras and technology, as well as money to support PBIS.

3. TSSA Goals

- -As mentioned previously, our TSSA budget was cut in half. They will allow for us to carryover more than 10% from this year to next. The school is hoping to save as much as possible as a "rainy day fund." There should be money to carryover after items for STEM lab have been purchased.
- -The Federal government put quite a bit of money towards public education in the stimulus bill. We may be able to have a full time social worker with the ESSR funds. Any remaining money will pay for paras and possibly manipulatives.
 - -ESSR funds will continue through the end of the 2024 school year.

4. SNAP map

- -Allison has called the new Police Chief for UPD, but he just started, so she is waiting to hear back from him.
- -Allison also spoke to Keith Bradshaw (Granite SNAP) and gave her information for the director of public works. She will reach out to him and invite him to do an analysis. He might be able to help with signs and crosswalks.
- -Dominion Energy has been in touch with the district in regard to utility work being done near the school. They should not be tearing out the sidewalk, so it should not interfere with students walking to and from school. Allison will ask for their plans to double check.

5. Budget

- -Used some funds to purchase some additional touch screen chromebooks to help SPED classes.
