1. Welcome & April Minutes

2. Elections

- Holli & Rachael's spots are up. Information on declarations of candidacy will go out via Blackboard and social media.

3. LAND Trust

-Our spending is within 10%. Most of our paraeducators are paid through LAND trust. Allison will check to see if some of the funds can be used towards PBIS.

-Goal is 5% increase in Pathways of Progress (POP) from middle of year to end of year.

4. TSSA Expectations

-Approximately \$37,518.12. A portion of these funds can carry over into next year. If we have to save a teacher, we do have enough money, just in case.

5. SNAP Map

-Allison attended SNAP map meeting. There is a concern @ Buena Vista due to students crossing the road without a crosswalk in order to cut through the new neighborhood. Matheson Community Council will also reach out to Jefferson Thomson to see if we can push on both sides.

6. ESSR/Budget

-ESSR 3 funding is in the bucket. \$133,000 for the year. It helps pay for half of our social worker, and the other half of STS. Playworks is also funded through ESSR, and we are hoping to hire a playground aide to help with recess.

7. Dress Code- Marie Roe

-Matheson Jr High has been discussing dress code for quite some time. Marie has noticed that a lot of the issues start at the elementary level. Discussed the possibility of issuing a blanket dress code that aligns with the rest of Cyprus Learning Network. Allison will look into having more streamlined guidelines.

8. School Logo

-Pleasant Green School staff members as well as School Community Council would like to change the school logo for Pleasant Green Elementary. An official vote was called. Voting in favor of the new logo was unanimous.

9. Citizenship

-The district has introduced new standards for citizenship with a very explicit model. There will be 5 main standards. Since we are at the elementary level, the standards will be reviewed by staff and implemented into the PBIS/Positive Panther Standards. New posters will be placed around the school.

-Student conduct violations/bullying will be very specific about how incidents are framed and will include action steps/intervention. Allison wants everyone to have an understanding of what bullying is vs just being disrespectful. If students are consistently being disrespectful over all situations, they are required to be put on a conduct contract. If they are unable to follow, they are referred to safe school and placed in an alternative setting.
