

PLYMOUTH ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE 2013-2014

The dress code policy is designed to prevent disruptions to the learning process. The administration reserves the right to add or adjust the dress code policy based on safety issues or the aforementioned.

1. Dress should be clean, modest, respectful and safe. Outer clothing should cover underwear. Revealing clothing is not appropriate.
2. Bare feet or flipflops are not permitted.
3. Skirts and slits in skirts may be no higher than mid-thigh.
4. Shorts should be no higher than mid-thigh.
5. Tops must cover the shoulders, midriff and navel.
6. Muscle T-shirts, tank tops, halter tops and spaghetti straps are not allowed.
7. Hats, bandanas, beanies, and hairnets are not permitted.
8. Clothing which may be interpreted as gang related, including gloves, numbers, belts or any kind of handwriting on clothes or body are not permitted.
9. Belts must not hang below waistline.
10. Sagging is not permitted
11. Clothing that advertises tobacco, alcohol, or drugs is not permitted.
12. Clothing which depicts criminal activity, violence, sexual content or disrespect toward any race, culture, religion, orientation or gender is forbidden.
