Chewing gum

Throwing rocks/snowballs*

Participating in inappropriate contact
(tackling, pushing, tripping, play
fighting, biting, pinching)

Play fighting

Fighting

Sliding on snow and ice

Use of wheels on school property

Using inappropriate web-sites

Be Respectful

Direct defiance towards an adult

Swearing (Offensive Language)

Backbiting, name calling, gossip

Minor Vandalism

Chronic Level 1 Behaviors

Demonstrating chronic minor

misbehavior more than 4 times per week

Level 3 Behaviors

Refer to Administration

(Documented as Office Referral in
Ed. Handbook)

Bullying

Sexual harassment

Racial harassment

Serious physical or verbal threats

Bringing weapons, using items as
weapons

Bringing or using illegal substances

Excessive Vandalizing

Showing severe defiance or assaulting
adults

Using obscenities direct at teacher

Stealing

Fighting (causes bodily harm to another
student - Blood)
