## Parent/Caregiver Responsibilities

*I will strive to . . .*

- Make certain my child comes to school well rested, fed and with assigned practice that has been checked.
- Have my child attend school everyday and be on time.
- Provide an appropriate environment and set a routine for studying.
- Participate with my child in doing school assigned practice activities.
- Empty and/or check the backpack with my child each day.
- Participate regularly in school and classroom activities.
- Communicate openly with my child and school staff.
- Provide for my child's physical and emotional needs, e.g. glasses, hearing aids, stability, support, etc.
- Attend SEPs and be involved in setting student goals with teacher and student.
- Support the school and teachers with the positive behavior program.

## Student Responsibilities

*I will strive to . . .*

- Have my materials ready for class and give my best effort on all assigned school work and tests.
- Always complete assigned practice by taking the assignments and materials home and turning it in on time.
- Communicate questions and/or problems to my teachers.
- Be respectful of others.
- Follow "The Patriot Way" for all areas of the school.
- Make good choices.
- Ask for extra support to strengthen skills.
- Never be afraid to ask questions if I don't understand what I am reading and studying or what the directions are.
- Actively participate in learning during each day at school.
- Make reading a daily habit.

## School Staff Responsibilities

*I will strive to . . .*

- Communicate with students and parents about student's progress and classroom learning.
- Create a positive, safe and caring learning classroom building positive relationships.
- Post proficiency based scores after assessments.
- Provide a variety of learning experiences in an effort to meet all students' needs.
- Model respect for students.
- Have well prepared lessons each day.
- Establish school goals based on needs assessment.
- Provide extended learning time.
- Involve parents and students in setting student goals.
- Use clearly defined, student-based learning targets.
- Create a learning environment where all students are actively engaged in meaningful experiences.
- Create consistency and high expectations for achievement and behavior.
