Our plan for this year:

This year we have \$61,302

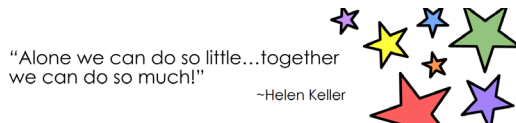
**we are using the money to pay for a teacher to help lower class size. This year, it is in 3rd grade.*

Our 3 school goals:

1. 65% of students in grades K-5 will make average or above average progress on Dibels by the end of the year.
We are on track to reach this goal. We are already at 63%.
2. 65% of students will make average or above average progress on Acadience Math or 80% of students will be proficient at basic math calculations
We are keeping track of this goal but don't know yet if the progress is typical.
3. At least 40% of students will meet their WIDA target goal.
We are actively working on this goal, also. WIDA tests are going on right now.

Priority standards for math:

Each grade level has worked together to choose the most essential standards/skills in math. They also worked with the grade level before and after to make sure that the standards we have were consecutive.

I can divide fractions and I identify that a fraction is a numerator (top number) divided by a denominator (bottom number).3. I can multiply a fraction.
