Discussion	Emergency Response Plan	
<p>Connie would like the SCC and the PTA to discuss ways to add to the emergency plan. Should children bring an emergency gallon bag filled with supplies that are stored at school? Does the school need additional snacks, solar blankets, or portable potties?</p>		
<p>The church at the corner is the first meeting place. Jason said he could get an emergency key for the church in case it is needed. CC members are asked to think about ways to obtain the necessary items for emergency kits in classrooms: flashlights, medical kits, food, water, blankets, first aid kits, garbage cans or some other item to carry and store the supplies. Possibly have a practice drill next year to reunite parents with children.</p>
