- Summarize progress and needs ( what area was the most growth achieved? What area was the least amount of growth achieved) We covered ELA and Math over the last two months meeting.
- School LAND Trust Plan approve new plan for 23-24 school year, Reading Achievement Plan and signature page due in March at schools.utah.gov/schoollandtrust, we discussed using land trust money to pay for .5 of a kindergarten teacher and paras to help improve the scores of our students in kindergarten on the end of year KEEP test. We talked about the use of paras to help with data collection and to give teachers time to dive into data and make decisions on what to do differently. A motion was made by Jason Johnson to approve the plan, it was seconded and approved by all members of the council. Part of this discussion was also on spending money from Title 1 budget to pay for one teacher in the upper grades.
- ✓ Review staffing plan- talked about numbers of projected students in each grade level, our reasoning behind where to put teachers. Why we had the need to have an additional teacher in kindergarten and the scores that warranted the proposed goals for the plan. We also discussed TSSA budget and spending the money on paying for two of the days a week for the social worker. Also spending from that budget for paras.
- Child Access Routing Plan (Safe Walking Route), using SNAP (Student Neighborhood Access Plan) through UDOT, due to the District Traffic Safety Committee by March 15, 2023 (elementary and junior high schools only) This was completed and submitted.
- ✓ Reunification drill struggles/ worries-just a drill, we will take great notes and adjust for the future based on what we learn in this process. Looking for some more help with Spanish speakers to help on the day of the drill.
