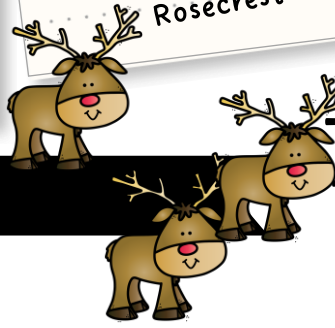
Mental Health Message from our Social Work Team
