

ROSECREST COMMUNITY COUNCIL MINUTES

April 27, 2010

The Community Council meeting was opened by Chair, Kathy Draper. Minutes were read and approved by the Committee. Members had received email copies of 2009-2010 School Plan Progress Report and the 2010-2011 School Plan for the School LAND Trust Program. Copies were received as a result of the plans being approved by the Granite School Board. The Feedback Form requested by the Granite School Board was again reviewed.

The Safe Routing Plan was studied using the Student Neighborhood Access Program (SNAP) map. SNAP provides resources to assist in the planning, education and encouragement of students to safely walk and bike to school. SNAP also works to decrease air pollution and traffic congestion around schools. The Granite School District is now utilizing the SNAP program for Community Councils to address safe walking routes to school for students. Council member, Becky Mott, worked on the SNAP map and that was presented to the Council for review. Council member, Becky Pettit, also shared a walking route plan which had been utilized in past years. Mrs. Pettit presented the idea of investigating grants in order to address the concern of no sidewalks in some areas and will provide additional information about her concerns to Mrs. Clarke. Mrs. Clarke will talk with the principal of Wm. Penn about the grant they received to have sidewalks constructed in parts of their community.

Legislative emails were presented, as well as the names of GSD Board members with the District address and it was requested that Community Council members write to as many as possible and express appreciation for Trust LAND funds and how the money for Rosecrest was spent.
