

Community Council Minutes for Monday, November 10, 2104

Call to Order of meeting 3:17 by Chair, Becky Pettit

Members present: Tina West, Nancy Hardy, Becky Pettit, Kelly Winslow, Jan Davis, Becky Mott, Michelle Prestwich.

1. Elections-Welcome to Michelle Prestwich our new Parent Member. Contact information for her will be posted on our website by Mrs West.
2. School Data—SAGE data raw scores reviewed by the council in detail—Mrs. West and Staff are reviewing the information closely as well—Preliminary initial scores were published—Formal School grade will come soon—Students and parents will get more specific SAGE information at SEP's in the Spring. Parents and students can check the portal for their individual student report.
3. School Wide Behavior Plan—Committee members reviewed the attached school wide behavior plan which will be included in the 2015 SSAP next year—this includes our anti bullying plan. This will be the published plan for our school.
4. Trust Lands Videos—Touch the Future and Earning for Education—**Touch the Future** and **Earning for Education** are the video titles. These are required each year for all community council members. Council Chair Becky Pettit made a request for all members to have completed watching the video's by the next community council meeting in Dec/Jan.
5. Trust Land Budget—All budgets and amounts were reviewed in detail by the council. This included substitute funds, spelling city, brain pop, and I-Pads.

Motion #2-Motion was made by Tina West, second by Kelly Winslow, vote was in the unanimous. We will purchase Brain Pop Jr.

Motion #3-Motion was made by Becky Pettit with a second by Becky Mott, Vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Motion: Move \$500.00 from software budget to equipment budget to buy 8(eight) I-Pad mini's

Motion #3-Motion was made by Tina West, second by Jan Davis-vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Motion: Move \$1,000.00 from text books budget to substitute budget.

7. Other items which were reviewed during the meeting: the Council wants to save some money to spend on apps during the year for the I-Pad's; UEN offers free of charge classes for the I-Pad; will

there be a Stem School on the East Side?; Rosecrest is a Technical and Art School; Halloween Parade procedures were reviewed and feedback and explanation were received; Band meets Tues and Thus after school-Orchestra meets Mon and Wed after school, numbers overall are down; Parking at the curb during school hours will be revisited with Kindergarten and Pre-K parents via Mrs. West to remind parents of the proper parking procedures at the school as coming and going is often a problem during the middle of the day.
