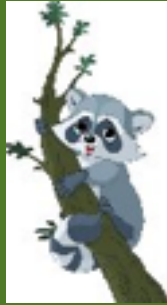

October Monthly Focus Goals

Kindergarten- Identify 13 upper and 13 lowercase letters

First- Spell CVC words; Read and write numbers to 100

Second- Writing conventions, descriptive; Addition to 20 by memory; Moon/Stars/Seasons

Third- Identify parts of speech (N, Adj, V, Adv); Know subtraction facts fluently

Fourth- Sentence structure and reading fluently; 3 digits by 3 digits subtraction; Fossils

Fifth- Parts of speech; Dividing whole numbers; Earth's surface

Sixth- Summarizing; Division; Light/Sound
