Grade Level Focus Goals for December:

Kindergarten: Know all letter sounds

First: Read first 50 sight words. Addition and subtraction within 20.

Second: Writing conventions. Subtraction to 20 by memory. Cultural Fair.

Third: Read a selection and determine main idea. Skip count verbally and in writing by 3s.

Fourth: Narrative writing. Math facts of 6-9 multiplication. Water Cycle.

Fifth: Five paragraph essay format. Add and subtract fractions. Heredity.

Sixth: Inferences. Fractions to decimals to percent. Moon phases.
