

Community Council Minutes

November 9, 2015 in the Office-Call to Order 3:15 p.m.

Member Attendance: Parent Members : Kelly Winslow, Michelle Prestwich, Michael Ferguson, Jan Davis, Patti Hession; School Members: Mrs. West, Mrs. Hardy, Mr. Frank

1. Trust Lands Budget Video: Mrs. West will resend link via email. Members who have not viewed will need to view prior to next meeting.
2. Council Position: Michelle Prestwich will serve as Secretary.
3. Trust Lands budget:
 - 6 Chrome Books ordered.
 - Brain Pop paid for from Textnology budget – outside of Trust Lands budget, but leaving on TL list in the event that it will be needed next year. (Cost this year = \$2200.)
 - Currently paying for three paraprofessionals through TL budget.
4. School Updates
 - Band and Orchestra After School Program
 - Student involvement has increased from last year (9-10 band, 14 orchestra).
 - Granite Foundation took 1-2 students on scholarship.
 - Michelle Prestwich will communicate options for students who also want to participate in chorus early for next school year.
 - Anti-Bullying Plan (now part of School Student Achievement Plan)
 - Plan includes Green Tickets as recognition, and problem solving with teachers and or Mrs. West. Problem solving always involves notifying parents on both sides of situation.
5. Driving and Parking Procedures
 - Mrs. West will include a reminder in the November newsletter and will include a safe walking route map as well as additional drop off/pick up points beyond the front entrance.
 - Idling for Air Quality: Nothing has changed from last year. Mrs. West will look into free materials available and will put signs up.
6. Doggie Poop and After School Vandalism
 - Ongoing issues: Animal waste still a problem on school field. Additionally, there are incidents of climbing on top of the crate, ruining the roof and tagging.
 - Action Items: Talk to Brian Howick about publicizing it at community council meetings. Also, have situation announced at church meetings to raise awareness.
7. SSAP
 - Rosecrest goals are literacy and math. Mrs. West will send home paper copies for community council to review when it is available.
8. Educator Evaluation:
 - All educators will receive a grade: 70% from evaluators (supervisors, 10% from the stakeholder input, and 20% from student growth based on Granite Benchmarks.)
