Community Council Meeting Minutes--March 21, 2016

Call to Order 3:17 pm

1. Trust Land Budget Update-Budget update and reviewed as presented by Tina West
Motion #1 –Made by Patti Hession and second by Michael Ferguson-passed unanimous in the affirmative: Use Trust Lands budget to purchase with Trust Land Funds, (Technology and Para professional’s), Finish funding paraprofessionals, 30 more Chrome Books and another cart, additional funds to the library for Beehive Books with plan to purchase an additional 10 Chrome Books next year from funds which would give the school 3 full carts.
Discussion for consideration for funds to help fund the new reading and math programs for ink cartridges, paper, and costs which may have need of funding, etc. next fall with funds that are available in the budget.
2. Trust Lands Progress Report and School Plan for 2016-17—Due March 23rd. Reviewed in full by all members for updates any changes.
Motion #2- Motion by Tina West, Second by Patti Hession-passed unanimous in the affirmative- Submit and sign Trust Land Progress Report. All members present signed signature page for submission following passage of the motion. Mrs. West will gather Michelle Prestwich signature.
3. Legislative Session Ending—Discussion on bills affecting public schools-Patti Hession
House Bill 201-SAGE for Seniors not included in the teacher grading system. Charter Schools trying for 25% more funding. Discussion--We have 2 new Charter Schools in the area coming which may affect our school and numbers as well as other schools in the area.
4. Further discussion on our FTE plan reviewed for next year which was submitted from our prior meeting. 50 recently registered for Kindergarten, plan for 3 sessions will be needed as we anticipated for FTE; 1st grade, 3 classes; 2nd grade, 3 classes; 3rd grade, 2 ½ classes-with rotation plan; 4th and 5th grade-2 ½ classes with rotation plan; 6th grade 2 classes—If we get extra FTE with any registration changes, 6th grade will be considered for hiring due to current class size. Mrs. West will be leaving to take a position at the District level; Rosecrest will have a new Principal next year. New ½ teacher will come from surplus at the District. We will have their names and meet them as soon as possible.
5. Driving and Parking Procedures—23rd east construction, alternative drop off/pick up—Tardies will not be excused, plan accordingly, go early, allow extra time. – Social media and copy of procedures were sent out/home.
