### Agenda Items:

#### **I. Welcome**

Mr. Anderson welcomed new Rosecrest Community Council Member Lori Thompson and showed the community council a training video outlining how a school community council works and members' job descriptions. The following positions were nominated by Mr. Anderson, seconded by Patti Hession, and voted on by the council. All voting was unanimous.

- a. Chairperson: Staci Henri
- b. Vice Chair and Note Taker: Nancy Hardy

Council members were informed they would be receiving an email in which they would digitally sign, indicating they were a council member.

#### **II. Student Achievement Data**

Mr. Anderson defined academic "growth" and "proficiency", as well as, the difference between the two terms.

According to SAGE Results, Rosecrest students have demonstrated 50% Proficiency in Mathematics the past two years. Mr. Anderson also provided 2018 MGP SAGE 4-6 data results showing Rosecrest's 2018 Growth was above all surrounding schools (Crestview, Highland Park, Canyon Rim, William Penn, and Upland Terrace). 2018 Pathways of Progress (DIBELS) showed Rosecrest at 68% Progress, which score was among the Top 10 in Granite School District Elementary Schools.

**III. Class Size**

Mr. Anderson explained the FTE process and the current teacher-student ratio (27.25) to council members. He explained as the result of an increase in student numbers, Rosecrest was extremely fortunate to gain an experienced, highly qualified full-time Kindergarten teacher, Mrs. Yeates, and a .5 Reading Specialist for grade 4-6.

Mr. Anderson also indicated Rosecrest was able to retain three valuable reading/literacy aides and two math aides with Trust Lands funds.

Mr. Todd Zenger, Granite School District School Board Member, addressed the council. In his remarks, Mr. Zenger praised Granite School District for being able to fill all teacher vacancies for the 2018-19 school year and remarked this was indicative in Rosecrest's obtaining Mrs. Yeates. He stated Granite School District was indeed a "Destination for Teachers" model, having a waiting list of qualified teachers from other districts seeking employment within GSD. He also noted, GSD educates 1/10 of the students in Utah and commended GSD teacher, administrators, and school for the outstanding work.

Mr. Zenger also reassured council members the community councils within the Olympus Network would be the decision makers regarding Olympus Reconfiguration, not the GSD School Board members, as they represented the communities involved.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:31 pm.
