- School Student Achievement Plan 2019
 - Plan is similar to that of previous years.
 - Goals – Improve academic proficiency & 100% parent contact at SEPs
 - Most SEPs will be traditional, face-to-face but other could be phone or email
 - The SSAP was unanimously approved by all SCC members
- Reconfiguration
 - An explanation of a meeting that took place at Olympus Jr High was given by Mr. Anderson. Teachers from grades 6-9 and principals were invited to attend and learn about the impact of a potential grade reconfiguration. GSD HR officials explained that typically teachers follow their students when reconfiguration occurs but there are many exceptions and unique circumstances. For example, if a 6th grade teacher wants to stay at their elementary and there is an opening that could be an option.
 - There will be another meeting at Olympus High on 1/30/19 for all SCC members. This meeting was requested by Crestview SCC. The goal is to share opinions and see if it is possible to get on the same page. Mr. Anderson encouraged SCC members to attend but it is not required. We reviewed our letter and current questions/needs in order for reconfiguration to be done “right.”
 - One change was made to our most current letter. The concern of a boundary study in conjunction with reconfiguration was removed. We believe a boundary is always possible and even likely regardless of reconfiguration.
- Trust Lands Plan
 - We reviewed our current plan 2018-2019. SCC is pleased with the work that our instructional aides are doing. This is where the majority of the funds are being spent.
 - Next year’s plan will likely not need as much money in the technology and textbook categories.
 - We will share ideas and begin to write the plan at our next meeting (Feb 2019)
