Agenda Items:

**I. Rosecrest Remodel**

- a. Mr. Anderson updated the SCC on the remodeling of Rosecrest, which will begin the week after school is out. The remodeling decisions have not been made lightly or without much thought and input. At this point, Rosecrest will have new carpet, paint, ceiling tiles, lights, blinds, technology, and updated classrooms with new millwork and furniture. He went over the different types of furniture which will be in each classroom.
- b. A “student” hub will be created for activities such as the school science fair, guest speakers, the Wax Museum, staging for plays, etc.
- c. The SCC committee walked out to the front of the building, so Mr. Anderson could discuss the planned landscaping updates. New shrubs will be planted and a small strip of lawn in front of the kindergarten classrooms, a first grade classroom and the computer lab will be removed.
- d. Lori Thompson questioned whether families would be needed to help with the move. While it does not appear at this time extra help will be needed, Mr. Anderson noted Lori’s offer to recruit families to help. It is expected district personnel will haul out the classroom desks and students will carry chairs to the playground on May 23<sup>rd</sup> as a ceremonial end to the school year.

**II. Reconfiguration**

- a. SCC noted there was no new pertinent information concerning the Olympus Network reconfiguration at this time. Reconfiguration must still be voted on. If

voting occurs prior to the end of the 2018-19 school year, it is likely the reconfiguration will take place in Fall 2020.

- b. Mr. Anderson stated that Rosecrest's Community Council letter, dated March 11, 2019, regarding Reconfiguration was submitted.

**III. Safe Routes Utah (required of every SCC)**

- a. Mr. Anderson presented each SCC member with a copy of the Safe Route Utah map for our community. He noted the name had changed from Safe Walking Routes to Safe Routes Utah.
- b. SCC members verified the accuracy of the map and confirmed no necessary additions or changes were necessary. Mr. Anderson will submit Rosecrest's Safe Route Utah plan.

**IV. Meeting in May? - The SCC determined it would not be necessary to meet in May.**
