- Trust Lands Plan
 - Review current plan (19-20)
 - Goals Reached 3 of 4 academic goals. We are happy with the structure of the current goals and will keep a similar structure for next year.
 - Spending About \$55,000 is being spent this year.
 - Write plan for next year (20-21)
 - Purpose, law, & appropriate expenditures
 - Goals 58% of students will demonstrate proficiency on both the math and ELA RISE test. We will also aim for a 58% MGP on both math and ELA.
 - \$ Allocation Due to reduced enrollment we will have a reduced dollar amount in the Trust Lands budget. We anticipate \$41,000 in allotment and about \$4,000 in rollover. The council discussed the plan and how to best reach our goals. It was determined that the best use of funds is employing hourly paraeducators. The council wishes to allocate \$44,000 to paraeducators and \$1,200 to support academic field trips. The plan received a motion to approve by Stacie Henry, a 2nd by Patti Hession, and was agreed upon unanimously by those in attendance.

 - Next year's plan (20-21)
 - Numbers not names We have been allotted 11 FTE due to program change (6th grade to Evergreen and decreased enrollment. The plan does not have much

wiggle room. We will have 1 Kindergarten teacher (2 classes) and 2 teachers on each grade level 1-5.
