Steve Hogan and Ben Horsley (in person) and Sheri Sorensen, Connie Burgess, and Shauna Jensen (on line) from the District Offices gave a wrap up of the 10-month DLI Boundary Study.

Sixty-six DLI students from Millcreek Elementary will move to William Penn in the 2023-2024 school year.

Rosecrest was evaluated as a DLI school, but was ultimately determined not to be a viable option. Primary factors influencing the decision:

- Schools need close to 600 students for a viable program. Rosecrest is just under 300
- A DLI program needs 4 classes in each grade. Rosecrest does not have enough room to accommodate that many classes
- Williams Penn already has a DLI program

The Council opted not to record the Christmas Program this year.

Council also agreed to cancel the December meeting due to the proximity to the Christmas Recess.
