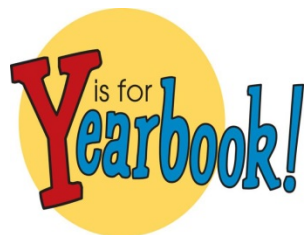


## Weekly Announcements for Skyline High School Students and Parents

The Yearbook Stomp is coming soon.....**Make sure you have already purchased your yearbook before May 24<sup>th</sup>**. Often students think they have already purchased a yearbook – only to find out the night of the stomp that they have not. Avoid having this happen to you – we are posting a list of all students who have purchased a yearbook this year by the bookstore window. Please make sure your name is on the list.

- If your name is on the list – that means we have your yearbook order.
- If your name is not on the list, you may purchase a yearbook prior to May 24<sup>th</sup>.
- If your name is not on the list and you feel already pay for a yearbook, please contact the bookstore and have them double check.
- Remember to pick up your yearbook early – at the Stomp on May 25<sup>th</sup> (instead of yearbook day on May 26<sup>th</sup>) you must have all your fees/fines paid, library fines taken care of, detentions served, lunch monies paid, etc. Remember to check your fees and fines on May 24<sup>th</sup> /25<sup>th</sup> (To make sure no new fees have been added.)
- **You will have until 11:30 on May 25<sup>th</sup> to make sure all fees are paid and everything is cleared, to avoid standing in the long bookstore line.**

# SENIOR INFORMATION PAGE

- Make sure you check your fees and fines regularly to make sure your account is up to date.

**Still need to pick up your Cap and Gown – you may come during lunch and after school on Monday, Wednesday and Friday to room 102. Remember to have your ID.**

- **In order to pick up your cap and gowns:**
  - All your current fees and fines (this includes parking tickets, hall violation tickets, cafeteria monies owed, etc.) must be paid or worked off. You must have clearance sheets for each hold you had on your cap and gown.
  - All detentions need to be served

- Your order from Jostens needs to be paid in full.
  - You must have ordered your Cap and Gown. If you have not, please see the information below.
  - **If you think you might have earned an Academic Cord (3.5 or higher total GPA) or Citizenship Cord (3.5 or higher CPA), please bring \$5 cash for each cord when you come to pick up your Cap and Gown.**
