It was arranged and completed with only 15-hours notice from the health department. It really was all hands on deck and is a display of the dedication Granite School District and Skyline High School has to keeping students able to attend school in-person. A special thanks to those involved. It was a couple days of disruptive announcements and some minor time out of class while testing. It ensured students were able to stay in school rather than be dismissed for 10 days. We are so pleased we have students here this week.
