1. Minutes: Motion by Alexander J. Smith to approve our November meeting minutes, seconded by Kathy Robinson. Motion approved unanimously.
2. Alisa Hamblin Community Council District Representative: talked about Panorama Survey and things parents should know about digital safety. It would be a good idea to get the district information from Alisa and have it sent to the parents. Talked about customized questions on the survey. We give the survey 3 times a year. Beginning, middle, and end of school year. Talked about intervention group to help students that are struggling.
3. Building Update: Hughes has started demolition on building B. Suppose to move into the Academic building Summer 2024. Not all classrooms will be in the building. We will be putting up a relocatable (relo) village on the west side in the new parking lot to accommodate those classrooms. Tennis courts will not be done by Spring. They have a special finishing that needs to go on the surface of the courts. They can only put it down when it is a certain temperature and will stay that temperature for a certain amount of time. Softball field will be ready for the 2023 season.
4. Land Trust: Implemented the changes in Land Trust. Land trust money will be going towards the AVID program. Syd Lott talked about the Freshmen Success class. There will be a teacher that will be assigned to 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> grades.

6. Principal Nerdin: PLC going very well. High Solution Tree is a new way to do training. We have more teachers working closely together since training in Las Vegas.

7. Counselors: They have quite a few students that are struggling with mental issues. Panorama has helped pinpoint students who would benefit from working with Victoria Hatton our school psychologist and Kathy O'Donnell our Social Worker.
8. Mitch talked to us about his principal retreat. He discussed some options that other High School principals have implemented in their schools to help with attendance and tardiness.
