2. Areas of data and growth desired in Mental health, digital safety, mathematics score – proficiency percentage on the Aspire plus, enhance and improve English Language Learners scores, increase enrollment in AP & IB, Support students who are failing, support core students.
 - a. Growth is the percent of students who have a base score and how much they have grown
 - b. ELL – score is based on the WIDA standards, based on individual growth
 - c. Growth of the lower 25% - lowest group from testing the previous year
 - d. Post secondary readiness – grad rate, ACT, % who score at a certain percentage, students in a more rigorous AP, IB, CTE Pathway
3. SMART Goals
 - a. SHS will reduce the percent of students not reaching proficiency by 10% on state assessments
 - i. ELA will move from 65-68
 - ii. Math will move from 52-57
 - iii. Science will move from 67-71
 - b. Graduation rate will raise from 94.5-96%
 - c. Increase the % of kids taking rigorous coursework from 93.4-95 (AP, IB, CTE Pathway)
 - i. Cross listed courses increase exposure for students

*Science is doing a great job, Awarded highest growth in the district
