2. Anyone want to be the new chair?-Sativa Watson would like to step down, she is also applying for a substitute teacher position in the district, which if received she will not be able to be our chair
3. New Development by Sonic on 6200 South and 4800 West area – not how they are getting to school, how many students (estimation)? Not Sure -When is it going to be finished?-No Date yet; People over Building and Development in the district are aware of this construction-another boundary study will be done at some point
4. Budget Updates-Final carryover numbers/2nd full day kindergarten?-We do not have everything yet, we will be short a ½ FTE-propose an amendment to pay for ½ a teacher out of Land Trust-Motion to amend the budget by Christine Figueroa, Seconded by Sativa Watson, All in Favor
5. Current Crossing Guards, Crosswalks, and pickup locations-Kindergarten has moved to the North side of the school, Have the Community Council contact the Municipality about crosswalks and crossing guards-Ahmed Dahir is the contact, Maybe have bigger signage or more signage around the school area; Steve has done some video recording and is working on the safety video; May speak to the Engineers-what are our options to get people to realize there is a school zone around South Kearns-Holly North will contact Ahmed Dahir
6. AR (Accelerated Reader) replacement-Did the teachers take a vote?-Have not moved forward with this, The school is looking at a widespread motivation and incentive with PBIS and Citizenship

7. Openings in the building (BHA, Special Education Aids, Playground Aids) were they filled?-Paras are still needed, No Playground Aids-maybe we can figure out a rotation of volunteers with SCC and PTA if nothing else
8. Safe Walking Routes-Bike or Walk to School Challenge, Promote this challenge, October 15th United Way and Cummins will have a Bike Safety Assembly and will give bikes to every 4th and 5th grader
9. Food Pantry will have cold items and will open when the refrigerator is repaired
