### Meeting Notes

- End of Year Testing Update
  - “Rise High” incentives going well.
  - Students have set goals with teachers and are tracking success in data planners
  - Students earn monthly incentives: bouncy balls, gliders, kites
  - Culminating activity- KJHS science department to come out in May for schoolwide rocket launch activity
  
- Staffing Update
  - Title I funding less than expected and OEK allotment for FTE reduced .5
  - Keeping 3 teachers on each grade level for next year
  - Unable to fund fulltime STS, Play Works program and in-house substitute teachers
  - Moving a couple of teachers next year to help with leadership positions
  - Boundary study happening for west side schools, thinking we might absorb students depending on district decisions.
  
- CIP Review
  - Reviewed data and test scores from last year
  - Discussed difference between “POP” goals and Benchmark goals
  - Reviewed this year’s academic, social disposition and teacher development goals
  - Suggestion to have the teacher development goal increase from 80% to 100% of teachers implementing iReady lessons in the classroom- Kim will take the suggestion to Leadership Meeting on Thursday.
  
- Catapult-new emergency system
  - Watched the information video
  - Planning to use the new system for the Earthquake and fire drill on Thursday (4/20)
  - All staff required to watch training
  
- Open Questions/Concerns
  - Traffic concerns- south side drop off
    - Buy more cones to put in middle of crosswalk to limit U-turns
  - Bus #356 turning quickly and too tight on corner
    - Kim will go out in the morning to observe
    - Need to add “no parking” cones to side of street
  - Dani asked what percentage of our students opt out of RISE testing
    - Kim will ask and report back next meeting
