- Principal/Leadership team discussing the need to implement a "walk to math" intervention time on Fridays to provide extra support for students with math. (Working on a block schedule for the 24/25 school year)

• Land Trust 2024/25

- Needs Assessment
 - Many students expressed a need for support (Panorama survey) in math.
 - "Walk to math" intervention next year (see above)
