

## Minutes - Taylorsville Community Council-February 22nd, 2017

There was a vote to approve January minutes. Natalie Paxton motioned to approve minutes; Natalie Andrew McLeran seconded the motion. Minutes were approved unanimously.

Ms. Liddell provided the current budget for Trust Lands with a total of \$86726.66. She explained each category breakdown and addendums at the bottom left (see February 2016 Trust Lands Budget for specifics, left hand side). The Board took a vote on the on the new proposed budget changes. Betsy Valora motioned to have the budget approved. Steve Garlitz seconded the motioned. The vote was unanimous.

Dr. Muse went over the THS Bullying report (see Student Bullying Questionnaire and Monitoring the Future inserts in 2017 THS CC minute binder). He gave us an overview of how THS students' results and how we compared nationally. Bev Workman had questions about certain statistics. Dr. Muse addressed her concerns. Susan Buttenob also had a question regarding of graduation rates. Dr. Muse (and Ms. Liddell) thoroughly explained the process.

Jake Brown, LIA and History teacher gave a quick overview on the Community Outreach program. It is to take place on February 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 6 pm, at Majestic Meadows Mobile Home Park. He stressed the need to make a connection with the Area 61 students and their families. By making this connection we hope to help further their education, while getting those parents involved in their children's educational process. It will be an on-going outreach program.

Eric Timpson gave the Counseling Center Update. He spoke of course selection process nearly completed and the ACT Test taking place on February 28<sup>th</sup>. He also mentioned the success of National School Counselor's week when pie was distributed to faculty and THS CC members. He also mentioned that another FAFSA night was set up for an undetermined date in early April.

Dr. Muse mentioned that THS would obtain a new scoreboard, installed over this summer.
