- 2. Approve Minutes from March 25, 2015 meeting (Natalie Paxton).**

- 3. Review Bulley Survey (Dr. Muse & Emily Liddell)**
 - Dr. Muse gave us handouts with stats on the bullying survey. This survey details the percentage of students being bullied physically, verbally, or a combination of the two.

4. Proposed Fall 2015 – 2016 Class Schedule (Emily Liddell)

- Enrollment numbers are currently at 1,687 but projected to be closer to 1,725.
- There will be 33 Special Ed. Self-Contained students in the fall. What this means is that they have three or more Special Ed classes.
- Capstone program: Taylorsville High is committed to the program. Starting with a slim number of students and then build from there.
- Humanities and Art History (Semester classes, but will count as a year course).
- School Success will now be a semester class.
- Math: College prep math does not qualify for Regents.
School Community Council voted in favor unanimously for the proposed Fall 2015 – 2016 schedule.
