

Community Council Meeting Minutes

March 14, 2016

Minutes from the February meeting were reviewed and approved. Becki motioned to approve the minutes, Christine seconded the motion. All present voted in favor. (2 min)

Digital Citizenship- There was discussion on safe technology use in school. At Truman we use computers, chrome books, iPads, and iPods. Students mostly use secured sites, there is very little google searching. There is a filter provided by the district, but it isn't perfect and students are trained on what to do if a suspect image or website comes up accidentally. All technology use by students must be supervised. Students are not allowed to use devices at school. (10 min)

School Land Trust Plan was presented, reviewed and discussed. T-time and CFA's were explained. Clover motioned to approve the plan, Becki seconded the motion and all present voted in favor. (10 min)

Staffing- Mrs. Christensen presented 3 different options for staffing next year. The council reviewed the options presented and decided that option 1 was the best one for next year. Alisha made a motion to approve option 1 and it was seconded by Gabriel Ruzzi. All present voted in favor. (15 min)

Public Comment/ Concerns:

SAGE testing schedule was discussed. 3rd grade – 6th grade participate in SAGE testing. K-2nd do Granite Benchmark testing. There was a brief discussion about how test scores are calculated to "grade" the school.

We have a new P.E. teacher- Mr. Charles. The teachers are happy to have a consistent P.E. teacher again.

The district has adopted a new reading program for next year that is aligned with the common core. Training to teachers will be provided and Mrs. Christensen is in favor of this new program. (15 min)
