In Attendance: Jared Broderick, Steffany Austin, Molly Upshaw, Rebecca Kirton, Anne VanHoose, Ellis Rygg, and Stacey Lowe

Motion: Molly Upshaw made a motion to approve the minutes from October. Stacey Lowe seconded the motion. The motion was unanimous.

1. Molly addressed the community council training video. She clarified which videos council members need to watch. Principal emailed appropriate videos to council members.
2. Principal's Report: Mr. Broderick shared that we have finished first term and teachers have been tasked to review school behavioral expectations. We have a net gain of 20 students coming back to school this term. He went over school COVID results. We have only had 1 case so far.
3. Spending: Our budget was 49,000. As of the meeting we have spent 7,00 on hourly wages. If nothing changes, we will spend 28,000 on hourly employees.
4. TSSA Funds: These funds were set up to pay for Brain pop and extra iready licenses. Brain pop is a sight where teachers can get lessons.
5. Discussion on Possible Extra Trustlands Funds: Rebecca Kirton suggested a program that can anonymously tell teachers ranked scores of class members presented in an engaging game form. We discussed the cost of newer Chrome books at 250-350 dollars each. We discussed a possible book drop for the library. We also discussed library books. Steffany Austin, will put a poster of teacher wishes.
6. Digital Citizenship: We discussed curriculum that could be used. Some of the teachers from last year got rid of the materials so that may not be an option. We need someone to do digital accommodations. Several teachers were mentioned with these skills.
7. Santa Store: Discussed COVID plan for annual Santa store.
8. Homework for all members: Review the Landtrust plan. Mr. Broderick showed us its location on the Truman web page.
