New amendments must address math and language arts. Looking at approximations, we have 15,000 left. Thought about replenishing and updating the library. Another suggestion is adding to classroom libraries. Another idea was helping the social worker with supplies. Mr. Broderick will check into it with the district. Next time we can follow up on an amendment.
