Welcome and Introduction

Approval of Minutes from February 2021: Motion was made to approve February minutes by Molly. Stacey seconded. All approved.

Principal's Report: The new projected enrollment is in. We are expecting to have 238 students next year. Sixth grade will be leaving to junior high. This is a drop in numbers. Based on these numbers, we have to look at a plan for staffing. 3 teachers will be leaving-2 sixth grade and one other teacher. We will already have 1 resource teacher, 3 unit teachers, and .5 all-day kindergarten are outside of this allotment. Based on the numbers, we will have split (dual grade) classes. We got an offer from the University of Utah to get 2 intern teachers that will be supervised by a veteran master teacher.

Landtrust Plan for 2021-22: Prediction of \$46,000 for Landtrust. We discussed funding a half-time teacher as an option. This would require another funding source for paraprofessionals. We also discussed how we can fund a half day social worker. Anne suggested using Landtrust hiring an aide for first grade in the morning. She also suggested a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) aide. Mr. Broderick said the Landtrust site is not up and ready. This changes the due date. We can finalize and vote next month.
