District Community Council Representative: We need a parent representative for the district. First meeting is October 26 at 6:00. They are quarterly. Steffany Austin made a motion that Ellis Rygg will be this representative. Jared Broderick seconded.

Halloween Parade: Jared Broderick stated the importance of community involvement in the parade. Reported the PBIS team had discussed the parade. The team wanted to continue to have a class party. We can have a parade outside. If we can't do it outside, we would do grade levels or do in the halls, but have it streamed. Some members were not excited about the streaming. Celebration will be Friday, October 29th at 9:30.

Amendments to the Continual Improvement Plan: Jared Broderick said Truman got an additional 72,000 dollars in ESSR funds in August. The school proposed an after-school program. Funding would go toward a stipend for the teachers. There would be a fall and spring session. We are looking at Monday and Wednesday for one hour. The stipend would be 100 dollars a day with the expectation of each teacher doing one hour of planning. We have seven interested teachers. Teachers gave a list of red and yellow students.
