Principal Information

In kindergarten, we will have 2 full time classes. We have to offer half day so half day students will be in an all-day class for half the day. We also got a small school grant for half a teacher.

Next year we have:

TSSA: \$72,000

Trustlands: \$39,335

ESSR: \$124,000

We have 2 choices for next year, which are no split classes (i.e. grade 3 and 4 in one class) or saving money for social worker time. The community council each shared thoughts and most supported using it for a teacher. All our teachers will be back except two special education units. We considered an interventionist.

Landtrust 2022-23:

We have the option of using or altering our goal from last year.

CIP Plan:

After School Programs: We all discussed this and felt we do not need

Paraprofessionals: Still concerned about hiring.

Paras for Substitutes: We couldn't do that because of district policy.

Coaching Cycles: We have very good coaches that individualize teacher needs. Don't need money for

this.

Letrs training: This is over, so we don't need money for this.

Principal Proposal:

Keep same goals, but elevated. Keep money going toward contracted people. The community council supports these ideas, but welcome other community input.
