

Community Council Minutes May 12, 2022

Review of Minutes from Last Meeting in April by Steffany

Approval of Minutes: Moved by Steffany Austin. Seconded by Stacey

Pick Up/Drop Off Data:

Jared reviewed the survey that was sent out by the school to parents and staff about the front drop off area. There were three options available and the option to write in an idea. Parents reported similar concerns as parents in the community council about drop off. Parents/staff supported better signs, regular communication, and people directing traffic. The survey had 40% support for Stacey Lowe's proposal. The proposal by Lacey Graham was support with 39% support. Overall, the parents selected keeping the traffic the same as it is now 30%, however, both proposals were also in the 30% range. 79% of respondents would like to discuss with the council. There was an idea to create a video about parking procedures. Mr. Broderick can reach out to the PTA and communication department about the video. Parent suggested better signs.

Continual Improvement Plan (CIP Plan):

Mr. Broderick reviewed the CIP. We reviewed the following goals

1. 50% of students will reach typical or above typical progress on end of year Acadience math and 60% on Acadience reading.
2. By the end of each quarter, teachers will improve engagement by 20% compared against baseline observation done at beginning of quarter. School will create a rubric.
3. Working on the social/emotional learning goal. Mr. Broderick reviewed that report cards for citizenship will be different with the CCLR (College, Career, and Life Readiness Standards).

Discuss Vacancies:

Ellis, Stacey, and Steffany's terms are up. Ellis will run again, and Stacey will run again. Steffany will report to the new principal that a new teacher election will need to occur. We will report vacancies as two, 2 year terms, and one 1 year term. The school will send out the messages and applications.
