Minutes:

Steffany reviewed minutes. Ashley George motioned to approve the minutes. Ellis Rygg seconded the minutes.

Landtrust:

We spent 100% of our funds from 2023.

CIP Goals:

Went over goals from 22-23 and 24. We increased the expectations from last year.

The goals for 2023-24 will be:

Academic

1a. At least 60% of students will reach typical or above typical progress on the End of Year Acadience Math assessment. This goal will be monitored by teachers completing progress monitoring as prescribed by the district state based on student proficiency. Additionally, teachers and coaches will collaborate and assess the BOY and MOY data to assess progress.

1b. At least 70% of students will reach typical or above typical progress on the End of Year Acadience Reading assessment. This goal will be monitored by teachers completing progress monitoring as prescribed by the district state based on student proficiency. Additionally, teachers and coaches will collaborate and assess the BOY and MOY data to assess progress.

Based on the 2023 WIDA Access Exam, the speaking part of the exam will increase to 60% proficiency for the 2024 school year.

Social Skills and Disposition

2a. 15% of students will experience a more supportive and inclusive school environment characterized by strong student-teacher relationships, a rigorous and fair set of expectations, a feeling of safety, a student's active ownership of their learning, and a strong feeling of belonging and of being valued. This goal will be measured and monitored by a school created rubric that will be used to survey students at the beginning of year (BOY) to establish a baseline and then compare it to the end of year (EOY) survey to determine growth. Additionally, students will be surveyed **MOY** to determine progress.

Talent Development Goals

3a. Teachers will improve **active** student engagement by utilizing the 4 chosen Kagan Strategies that we began using during the 22-23 school year (Think-Pair-Share, Jot Thoughts, Numbered Heads Together, and Rally Coach.) Each quarter another strategy will be added and drop in observations and surveys for teachers using the strategy will be given at the beginning of the school year and the end of the year.

School Staffing:

We have figured out how to have 2 teachers per grade. We hired a 5th grade teacher. We have 2 interns. We have posted for third grade.
