School Safety Plan (Flores)

- *Black Box was found and placed by the office.*
- *Ernesto reached out to Donny from Taylorsville City, but had no success. Interest of the CERT Program with the city was brought up.*
- *Brett Nelson, school Vice Principal and over safety, presented the school's SERP (School Emergency Response Plan) plan, which is updated each year from a template form that is filled out with information pertaining to the school. There are 2 teams to the plan. First team is the emergency responses team, which consists of individuals who would respond to the emergency. The second team is the emergency responders that would respond to the people who are injured. The emergency evacuation site is the Taylorsville, Utah Central Stake Center just East of the school. Personnel/staff from the school have been assigned to stay long term with students if needed, until they are picked-up by parents. The plan includes different steps for different emergencies and the protocols to follow. The plan also states the dates when emergency drills should be completed. He will also send an email with plans to council members so they can review and make sure the plans is on the school websites or a link to the plan.*
