

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to Wasatch Jr. High. We are excited to begin the new school year. The updates to the building are almost complete and ready for the new school year. It's going to be a great year, so let's get it started. Please read the following carefully as there is a lot of information.

The following steps will aid you in preparing for the 2017-18 school year.

1. Go to our new YouTube channel and watch the video. This will answer many of your questions. Please save this site as we will stream the school announcements and post them later as well as post videos of school activities throughout the year.

2. Go to our school website, fill out the forms, and pay fees as shown in the YouTube video. <http://schools.graniteschools.org/wasatchjr/registration/>.
3. Remember all 7th grade students need updated immunizations and boosters. These are required by the State of Utah to be completed before school begins on August 21, 2017 or your student will be sent home. Please bring a copy to the front office Monday-Friday, 8am-3pm from now till school begins.
4. August 18th from 1:00-5:00pm, you may pick up your student's schedule and locker. The school will be open to find your classes and try out your locker. Custodians, Administration, SBOs and Cheerleaders will be available to answer questions and help.
5. August 21st—First day of school. Orientation for 6th and 7th graders, normal day for the 8th graders. The 6th graders will all meet in the auditorium for 1st period and the 7th graders will meet in the Gym for 1st period and 8th graders will go to their normal 1st period class when school starts at 7:45am. More information that is specific will come out next week in an email and on our YouTube channel.
6. Bring any signed registration papers on the first day of school. 6th grade should bring the papers to the auditorium, 7th grade to the gym and 8th grade to their 1st period teacher. The papers will be collected in those locations.

Other Important Notes and Answers

1. On the first day of school, students should come prepared with a writing utensil and a folder with some paper. Students will receive supply lists and class disclosures from teachers the first few days

2. We will be watching the Solar Eclipse during the day. We have purchased special glasses to observe this once –in-a-life-time event.
3. Tryouts for Dance Company for 7th and new to the school 8th graders will occur on August 24th and 25th at 3:00pm after school in the dance room.
4. Elections for 7th grade Class Officers will begin the week of August 28 – September 1
5. Intramurals for Boys and Girls Soccer and X-Country (1.5m distance running) will begin the week of August 28 – September 1
