

## What is the Warrior Way Service Award



The Warrior Way Service Award is an award for you, our school, and our community. This is a great opportunity for you to participate in worthwhile service projects. ### Requirements



All you have to do for this award is participate in, or give 30 hours of service during the current school year. Every time you participate in a service project, or activity, you must record the date of the project, the amount of hours, description of service and get a signature of a parent or someone who supervised you on the project.

## How Can You Receive The Warrior Way?



The award is easy and fun to receive. All you have to do is plan or participate in a service project or activity. As long as you plan or participate in the project, you can gain the hours.

Wasatch Leadership Team (WLT) members, Student Body Officers, and Cheerleaders cannot count the projects they do for school toward their service hours. However, activities beyond normal group activities may be counted toward this award.
